SWIM LESSONS AT THE GLEN POOL

Our Pool contractor, World Pool, will be offering swim lessons beginning the week of June 26th. The lessons will be offered in two week sessions (Monday-Friday). The first day will be a screening session followed by eight (8) instructional days, with a rain day/makeup day if needed. Each participant will receive an individual evaluation at the end of the session. The cost of the group program is \$55. Payment is made on the first day of each session, payable to "World Pool". Stop by the pool for more details on the times offered.

Private lessons are also available. There is a sign up sheet located at the front desk at the pool. The cost of a private lesson is \$20 per half hour. Payment is made to the instructor. Classes are not held if it is raining. Take advantage of this great opportunity!
