# Don't Be Left Out; Express Your Views

On September 14, Fairlington Glen Board President Ray Alexander issued a letter that was hand delivered to all Glen addresses and mailed to all off-site co-owners indicating how the Glen can voice its opinion on the City of Alexandria's proposal to prohibit left turns from N. Quaker Lane onto S. 36th Street into Fairlington Glen.

Alexandria has jurisdiction over that intersection, and the City's Traffic and Parking Board delayed a vote on the no left turn issue at its meeting in July. The issue will be up for a vote at their meeting on Monday, October 22 at 7:30pm at the Alexandria City Hall, located at 301 King Street.

If you rent a home in Fairlington Glen, then you're part of our community association, and we welcome you! Your neighbors and the Board will look forward to meeting you at our community events, meetings, and social gatherings.

Sometimes we cannot reach you to announce a party or a meeting or share important news, especially if you're leasing from an out-of-state owner. If this is you, please sign up for our Glen Alerts. Go to <a href="https://www.fairlington.org/glenindex.htm">www.fairlington.org/glenindex.htm</a>. Scroll to the bottom of the home page until you see "Glen Alerts—E-mail Notifications" and sign up. When you subscribe, you will get newsletter e-mail alerts linked to this monthly newsletter, the Glen Echo.

We also suggest that you join the Fairlington Glen Yahoo Community Group. Go to <a href="www.yahoo.com">www.yahoo.com</a> and click on "Groups." In the search box, enter "Fairlington Glen" and this should bring up the Glen Yahoo Group. Click on the group name and that will send you to the home page. Look for the "Join This Group" tab in the upper right corner, click it, and then enter your Yahoo ID or create one. Once you use or create an ID, a message will be sent to the moderator of the group in order to confirm membership. The Glen group is only open to members of the Glen community. In case your landlord hasn't passed along this information, here are a few tips to make living in the Glen enjoyable and stress free:

- 1. All residents, both co-owners and renters, must comply with the association rules and regulations. They are reasonable rules that protect property values, preserve the nature of our community, and help make life more enjoyable for everyone. The Fairlington Glen Handbook can be found on our website. Take some time to look it over and familiarize yourself with it. The association has the legal authority to enforce all rules, which we do both equitably and consistently.
- 2. Renters are entitled to all of the privileges of co-owners with the exception of voting.
- 3. You don't have to own your home to be interested in your community. If you'd like to volunteer for a committee or some other type of service to the Board, then we cannot wait to meet you. Responsible, service-minded residents are the backbone of Fairlington Glen...regardless of ownership status.

# Leasing Your Unit

Co-owners are responsible for the actions of their household members, tenants, guests, invitees, employees, and agents. Any lease or rental agreement for a unit must be in writing and must require that the tenants abide by the master deed, bylaws, and the policies and rules in the Glen handbook. Detailed requirements are contained in Policy Resolution 97-1 "Unit Leasing" in the appendix.

# Arlington E-CARE Fall Recycling Event

Arlington County's fall Environmental Collection and Recycling Event (E-CARE) is set for Saturday, October 13 from 8:30am to 3:00pm—rain or shine.

Join the recycling efforts in the parking lot at Thomas Jefferson Middle School at 125 S. Old Glebe Road. That's just one block east of Glebe Road and one block south of Route 50. Bring your ID to verify residency.

Dispose of old or expired household hazardous materi-

als (HHM) such as small metal items, electronics, TV's and computer monitors. There is a \$15 fee for each computer monitor and a \$20 fee for each TV containing cathode ray tubes. These fees are payable by cash or check only. Large wooden console TV's will not be accepted. LED or LCD monitors and TV's are free.

Acceptable small metal items include pots, pans, tools, pipes, Venetian blinds, small appliances, and metal items fitting in an 11.5 inch by 46 inch opening.

Bikes For The World will accept serviceable and repairable bicycles to be sent to countries where they are needed for basic transportation. A \$10 donation per bike is requested to help with shipping costs.

Art For Humanity will collect gently-used but functional shoes, clothing, linens, microwaves, air conditioners, rugs, mattresses and bed frames. Winter clothing is most needed.

In addition you can donate eyeglasses and durable medical equipment like hearing aids, wheel-chairs, walkers, canes, crutches, and strollers. They will be cleaned and sent to clinics overseas run by volunteers.
